## Heat Policy *applicable to WBA Junior Comps*

If the inside temperature reaches 30°C the competition manager must consider implementing modified timing rules and if the temperature reaches 35°C **must** implement those timing rules.

The timing rules are set out in the amended By-laws which are reproduced in a full document kept at the WBA office. A copy of the By-laws is available upon request during business hours Monday to Friday.

### TIMING RULES

*(Based on all WBA Junior Competitions)*

## 2 Halves of 18 minutes duration

**TIMEOUTS: 2 timeouts per half**

**\*1 compulsory timeout per half.**

**To be called by Referee closest to the 9 min. mark**

**LAST MINUTE OF 1<sup>ST</sup> HALF:** Clock stops on every whistle

**LAST 2 MINS. OF 2<sup>ND</sup> HALF:** Clock stops on every whistle

**Half time interval shall be 2 minutes, Timeout interval shall be 1 minute.**

#### **\*Compulsory Timeout**

**It is recommended that during this time coaches ensure their players receive liquid replenishment and that they are encouraged to rest**
